**DATE: Saturday April 25th, 2026 - ENTRIES: Pre-Registration and Pre-Pay is Mandatory to Reserve Spots MUST BE 14 or OLDER TO ATTEND – Anyone under 18 must be 100% accompanied by a parent at all times.**

Limited to maximum of 30 Entries Pre-registration Opens for Members & Members Family Only March 1<sup>st</sup> 2026

NFGA Members and Family have preference until 3/31/26. Then Public 1<sup>st</sup> come 1<sup>st</sup> served.

Non-members may Register starting 4/1/2026 A waiting list will be maintained if the clinic fills to capacity.

**FEES: All entries \$75.00 per person.** Match fee included in clinic fee.

Fee includes the use of club AR15 A2 rifle .223 ammunition and individual one on one coaching during all live fire.

**Make checks payable to Nashua Fish and Game Assoc. Checks destroyed if event is rained out / cancelled.**

**No Refunds unless Minimum 7 days prior to event cancellation notice.**

**Paper Check Mailed in Advance is the Only Form of Payment accepted.**

**EQUIPMENT:** AR-15A2 Service Rifle. Rifles are provided for Clinic use by NFGA

**TIME:** Report to Clubhouse to Sign in 7:30 – 7:45AM Classroom Begins at 8:00 AM.

If not present and signed in by 7:50 am your spot goes to people in line on the waiting list. No Refunds for No Shows.

**Eye & Ear Protection is provided by students and is mandatory for all Students during all time on the range**

**Range Firing will commence at approximately 10am after classroom training is complete.**

When heading to the range all students will park behind the 300-yard line and walk up to the 200-yard line to be squadded

Students will be squadded 3 students to each numbered firing point.

All students will rotate shooting, scoring on the line and pulling targets in the pits all on the same firing point for the day

If any student is uncomfortable shooting the sitting or standing stages, they are welcome to do all firing from prone position

If any student is uncomfortable shooting prone sling supported, you will be set up to shoot off a bag / rest

All students will have an experienced / helpful coach right by their side during all live fire

#1 Goal is Safety #2 Goal is to have fun while learning the basics of competitive Service Rifle shooting

**CLINIC / MATCH - COURSE OF FIRE:** All fired from 200 yards -

Two 3 shot sighting groups Prone position, then four single fire sighters. Then match is 40 Shots for record. -50 Shots Total

10 record Shots Prone single load

10 record shots Prone Rapid. Load and 2 Rd Mag then 8 Rd Mag in 70 seconds (mag change optional if desired)

10 record shots Sitting Rapid. Load and 2 Rd Mag then 8 Rd Mag in 60 seconds (mag change optional if desired)

10 record shots Standing / Offhand. Single load

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** Dress for the weather. No Lunch break, we eat on the go. Estimate Complete by 2pm.

Bring your own Eye and Ear protection. Also bring food and water as none is provided or available at the range.
