### NHPRL EVENTS INTENT:

FUN Opportunity for Newer Shooters to get Assistance, Coaching & Practice to help prepare them for attending the full 600 yard distance XTC Sanctioned Events. **Coaching is Encouraged.**

### **This year we are trying something different:**

For more efficient range utilization and with high hopes to increase attendance we have set the dates for 5 of these events to align with the Military Rifle matches and Non NRA 3x600.

These NHPRL matches will start after the completion of the Military Rifle matches.

Bipod Shooters will be Welcome and Encouraged to shoot in the Military and NHPRL events.

**Newer Shooters can get 600 yard coaching in the Non NRA 3x600 matches that follow these.**

Please see the Event Bulletins for those events to see how fun and easy this will be for you.

### MATCH DATES AND START TIMES:

Sunday 4/27: 9AM Start- Squadding Opens at 8am at the 200-yard line (free 600 practice after)  
Sun 5/4, Sun 9/21, Sun 9/28, Sat 10/4 and Sat 10/11 Squad 200-yard line. 8am – Approx. 9:45  
Firing will begin after the completion of the Military match scheduled before these events.

**FEES: \$10 per Event:** Exact Change Greatly Appreciated. \*Make any Checks payable to NFGA  
Juniors (<25) Match Fee & Ammo are Free! (Paid out of NHPRL League fees / not from NFGA)  
1 Time per Year \$5 NHPRL League Registration Fee (Does Not Apply to Bipod shooters)  
You ID what club you are shooting for at Registration - Goes to highest shooting club award.

### EVENT RULES:

All NFGA cross functional and Leveridge Range specific rules apply. **No muzzle Brakes Allowed**

All Current NRA High Power Rules apply except > **Coaching is Allowed to help shooters learn.**

Empty Chamber indicators Mandatory to be in chamber at all times when not actively firing.

No less than 68 grain .223 ammo may be fired at 600 yards.

Leveridge **Muzzle Down** rule when closing the bolt strictly enforced to keep NFGA Open...

Failure to do so will result in an ejection from the event with no refunds.

### TARGETS:

NFGA Shotmarker <https://autotricker.com/pages/shotmarker> electronic targets will be used.

All participants are highly encouraged to bring their own Wi-Fi tablet or smart phone to be used with the electronic targets. Limited NFGA owned loaner tablets available.

**COURSE OF FIRE:** 500 Points / 50 Rounds for Record

**Stage 1:** Offhand 200 yards – No Sling Support

15 Minute Block Time for Prep Period & Unlimited sighters: Then 10 record slow fire shots.

**Stage 2:** Sitting Rapid 200 yards – Sling Supported

5 Minutes Prep & unlimited sighters then two 10 rd. Sitting Rapid strings in 60 seconds.

Must be a mag change in each 10-round string. (\* Mags can be loaded 2 & 8 or 5 & 5)

If there is an Alibi String - Other / Non-Alibi Shooters may fire a practice string.

**Stage 3:** Prone Rapid 200 yards – Sling Supported

5 Minutes Prep & unlimited sighters then two 10 rd. Prone Rapid strings in 70 seconds.

Must be a mag change in each 10-round string. (\* Mags can be loaded 2 & 8 or 5 & 5)

If there is an Alibi String - Other / Non-Alibi Shooters may fire a practice string.

**Rapid Fire stages will be called with NRA commands-**

Shooters are allowed to stand and shoot CMP / Style if they choose to. (\*Valuable EIC Practice)

(\*Mag changes are not mandatory for Out of Competition Bipod shooters - but they can safely)

**RIFLES:**

Intended for NRA / CMP XTC (Cross the Course) Service and Match Rifles.

(Sling Supported in Sitting and prone)

**NOTE: AR Tactical shooters.**

Take your bipod off, attach a sling mount and and you are now a Match Rifle. 😊 More FUN!

**No muzzle Brakes Allowed in any Leveridge scheduled events.**

**RANGE SAFETY:**

Participants are required to show up with a minimum of a known 100 yd zero and with a safe properly functioning Rifle with safe and appropriate ammo.

Any participant not on paper after 5 shots will not be allowed to continue firing.

**Seek RSO / Coach for Help BEFORE this happens.** No match fee refunds after firing starts.

**NOTE: \*All Leveridge Events- You Destroy it You Pay for it**

You shoot an E Target Sensor; you pay \$50 each. Shoot Sensor Wires, you pay \$20 each.

**Payment is Due the day you destroy it.** Once payment is received you are welcome to return to future Leveridge events. See the underlined text under **Events Rules** in this event bulletin.

**AWARDS:** \*Annual banquet at the start of each season
