OPEN TO: Any / All shooters with known rifle zeros and the proper safe equipment.

AMMO: Not provided – Competitors are to provide safe ammo for their rifle. NO Tracer Ammo Allowed.

RANGE OPERATION:

Empty Chamber Indicator Mandatory - No Muzzle Brakes Allowed.

Shotmarker Electronic Targets Will be used so bring a wifi tablet or smartphone.

SAFETY- (*Applies to all Leveridge Events) Eye / Ear Protection is 100% shooters responsibility.

Trigger Fingers are to stay OUTSIDE Trigger Guard until you are aiming at your target.

Typical Leveridge Strict Muzzle Down policy applies 100% of the time when closing bolts on live ammo.

This Match is typically fired by Rifle Shooter's that want to have a fun day shooting Vintage Military yet quality and safe firearms like M1A, M1 Garand & Carbine, Springfield, Mauser, Enfield, SKS and more. Anyone that can't stay on target or breaks safety rules will not be allowed to continue firing. No refunds.

This is easily avoided by shooting and zeroing the rifle you will use at 100 yards before this event.

All Modern Rifles Are Also Welcome to Shoot This Event:

This is all fired at 200 yards so even a 16" barreled AR15 with a red dot sight could safely be used.

Shooters are 1000% welcome to shoot the entire match off a bipod or sturdy bag support in prone the entire match if they are not comfortable shooting sitting or standing

COURSE OF FIRE

Coaching is allowed by experienced shooters to keep newer shooters safe and comfortable.

Prone Slow Fire:

2 Sighters and 20 Shots for Record in a Block time limit of 25 Minutes.

Prone Rapid Fire: (No Prep period - No sighters)

10 shots Prone in 70 seconds with a magazine change. (New shooters may skip mag change)

Sitting Rapid Fire: (3 Minutes Prep, 2 sighters in prep period)

10 shots Sitting in 60 seconds with a magazine change. (New shooters may skip mag change) **Standing / Offhand:**

Prep Period, 2 Sighters and 10 Shots for Record in a Block time limit of 15 Minutes

Shooters are 100% welcome to shoot prone, bipod or bag supported for the full event if there is a concern for safety or for shooting / destroying any Shotmarker components.

LEVERIDGE ELECTRONIC TARGETS POLICY – You Shoot / Destroy it you pay for it >>* Sensors \$50 Each / Sensor Cables \$20 each \$ due at match day <<* (*Sensors are 6 feet apart - Rarely happens if shooters have at least a 100 yard zero)

OPTIONAL 600 Yard Practice After for any 600-yard capable rifle / shooter:

*30 minutes max per shooter - Squadding for this will be separate after the match is complete.
