Sun 5/4, Sun 9/21, Sun 9/28, Sat 10/4 and Sat 10/11

Squadding Opens at Noon at the 600-yard line.

Firing will begin after the completion of the NHPRL match scheduled before these events.

EVENTS INTENT:

Opportunity for Newer Shooters to get; Assistance, Coaching and Practice to help prepare them for attending the NRA Sanctioned Events. Meet and get to know likeminded shooters.

This year we are trying something different:

For more efficient range utilization and with high hopes to increase attendance we have set the dates for these Non-NRA 3x600 events to align with the Military Rifle and NHPRL matches.

These 3x600 matches will start after the completion of the NHPRL matches.

Bipod Shooters will be Welcome and Encouraged to shoot in the Military and NHPRL events.

EVENT RULES:

All NFGA cross functional and Leveridge Range specific rules apply. **No muzzle Brakes Allowed**

All Current NRA High Power Rules apply except > **Coaching is Allowed to help shooters learn.**

Empty Chamber indicator is Mandatory to be in chamber at all times when not actively firing.

No less than 68 grain .223 ammo may be fired at 600 yards.

Leveridge **Muzzle Down** rule when closing the bolt strictly enforced.

Failure to do so will result in an ejection from the event with no refunds. Ask for help if needed

TARGETS:

NFGA Shotmarker <https://autotricker.com/pages/shotmarker> electronic targets will be used.

F-Open / FTR shooters will electronically set the target to the Proper F Class scoring target.

Standard NRA MR1 600-yard target faces will be used on all backers.

NOTE: *Rifle / Ammo Combo must be supersonic at the target for the targets to record shots.

All participants are highly encouraged to bring their own Wi-Fi tablet or smart phone to be used with the electronic targets. Very Limited NFGA owned loaner tablets available.

COURSE OF FIRE:

Three Strings of 20 shots for record at 600 yards. Total of 60 rounds for record.

Match 1 Reasonable Amount Unlimited sighters then 20 shots for record.

*Shooter will clearly state "going for record" to the scorer when ready for record shots.

*Matches 2 & 3 - Two Sighters and 20 shots for record. Infiltration will be used.

Shooters Choice to shoot 1, 2 or all 3 strings of fire. You do need to score others on your point.

RIFLES:

NRA Any Rifle (Any Sight), Palma Rifle, Service Rifle, F Class Open Rifle, FTR or AR Tactical.

Any safe rifle that meets all Leveridge range rules.

Light barreled hunting rifles may be used but you may not want to shoot all 3 strings of fire.

(*Light barrels get very hot putting this many rounds thru them this fast. =Not Good)

No muzzle Brakes Allowed in any Leveridge scheduled events.

Range Safety to Keep NFGA Open

Participants are required to show up with a minimum of a known 100 yd zero and with a safe and properly functioning Rifle with safe / appropriate ammo for that rifle.

Any participant not on paper after 5 shots will not be allowed to continue firing.

PLEASE - Seek an RSO or Coach before this happens. No match fee refunds after firing starts.

On a Similar NOTE: *All Leveridge Events- You Destroy it You Pay for it

You shoot an E Target Sensor; you pay \$50 each. Shoot Sensor Wires, you pay \$20 each.

Payment is Due the day you destroy it. Once payment is received you are welcome to return to future Leveridge events. See the underlined text under Events Rules in this event bulletin.

AWARDS: One Free Entry to a 2026 NRA Prone Event (\$30 Value)

The Leveridge Range Governor will Award ONE Free Entry Certificate to a 2026 NFGA NRA Sanctioned Prone Match to Any NFGA Member that shoots all 5 of these Non-NRA events AND at least 3 of the Fourteen 2025 Leveridge Scheduled NRA Sanctioned Prone Events.

*Any Events Rained Out, Do Not Count towards requirement for shooting all 5 of these events.
