Five Range Dates of TRIFECTA Events

3 Matches Back-to-Back in One Day

All Rifle Classes Welcome in All Events

MATCH DATES – 5 FIVE / FUN Days

Sunday 5/4, Sunday 9/21, Sunday 9/28, Saturday 10/4 and Saturday 10/11.

On these days we are trying something new this year.

A Trifecta of 3 events back-to-back.

Squadding will open at the 200-yard line at 8am.

We will begin at 9am with the Military Rifle Match that is 30 rounds for record all fired at 200 yards from the prone and standing positions.

-Right around 10am when the Military Rifle Match is complete:

We will then start the NH High Power Rifle League (NHHPR) match. These are fired from Standing and Sitting Rapid at 200 yards and then Prone Rapid at 300 yards.

Note: Rifle rapid stages of fire are 10 rounds per string with a mag change. 60 seconds for 200 sitting rapid & 70 seconds for prone rapid. Fully aimed and controlled, NOT spray and pray 😊

-Right around Noon we will be ready to start 3x600 Mid-Range Prone event.

These were formally Members Only Prone matches designed for NFGA Leveridge certified members that were / are newer shooters to get them some coaching and experience with the goal of getting them fully comfortable to attend the NRA Sanctioned 4x600 and 300/500/600 yard Mid-Range prone events. Non-member experienced shooters that frequent Leveridge XTC and Prone events will now be welcome to attend these events as opposed to just Leveridge Certified members. Non-Members will pay Double the (\$5) Fee of NFGA members.

Bipod shooters who typically only shot slow fire prone only events will be fully welcome and encouraged to attend the Military and NHHPR events where there is position shooting and rifle rapid fire stages. They will be welcome to stay prone on bipod all day if wanted.....

One of the goals here is to get them to see how fun and challenging it is to shoot from standing and then use a sling in sitting and prone. All 60+ of the AR Tactical Rifles Jim Langevin and I built for members to get them into Prone AR Tactical events can easily pop the bipod off and put a sling mount on the front rail and shoot from common sling supported positions to have fun with some more challenging types of shooting.

Sadly - All 3 of these matches in the past were typically, most always fairly lightly attended. The hope here is to increase participation in all of these events by combining them all into one day. This way all shooters have the option to shoot one, two or all three of these matches.

Other benefits are-

Less separate days that Leveridge is occupied with scheduled events

Reduced work time for my committee setting up and taking down the electronic targets.

EVENT RULES:

All NFGA cross functional and Leveridge Range specific rules apply. **No muzzle Brakes Allowed**

All Current NRA High Power Rules apply except > **Coaching is Allowed to help shooters learn.**

Empty Chamber indicator is Mandatory to be in chamber at all times when not actively firing.

No less than 68 grain .223 ammo may be fired at 600 yards.

Leveridge **Muzzle Down** rule when closing the bolt strictly enforced.

Failure to do so will result in an ejection from the event with no refunds.

TARGETS:

NFGA Shotmarker <https://autotricker.com/pages/shotmarker> electronic targets will be used.

F-Open / FTR shooters will electronically set the target to the Proper F Class scoring target.

Standard NRA MR1 600-yard target faces will be used on all backers.

NOTE: *Rifle / Ammo Combo must be supersonic at the target for the targets to record shots.

All participants are highly encouraged to bring their own Wi-Fi tablet or smart phone to be used with the electronic targets. Very Limited NFGA owned loaner tablets available.

RANGE SAFETY to KEEP NFGA OPEN:

Muzzle Down when Closing Bolts on a Live Round Strictly Enforced. Event Ejection may result if you won't or can't follow this rule. (No Refunds) Please ask for help early if having difficulty. Participants are required to show up with a minimum of a known 100 yd zero and with a safe properly functioning Rifle with safe and appropriate ammo.

Any participant not on paper after 5 shots will not be allowed to continue firing.

PLEASE - Seek RSO / Coach help before this happens. No match fee refunds after firing starts.

NOTE: *All Leveridge Events- You Destroy it You Pay for it

You shoot an E Target Sensor; you pay \$50 each. Shoot Sensor Wires, you pay \$20 each.

Payment is Due the day you destroy it. Once payment is received you are welcome to return to future Leveridge events. See the underlined text under **Events Rules** in this event bulletin.
