DATES: June 28th, July 13th, August 9th, August 24th, and September 7th.

Start Time: 9am Start times for all matches.

LOCATION: Nashua Fish and Game Assn., 21 Al Paul Lane Merrimack, NH.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all competitors in any or all matches.

ENTRIES: No advanced entries. Squad and pay on each of the match dates.

SQUADDING: All Squadding at 08:00 – 8:45am on the 300yd. Line.

FEES: \$30.00 for adult, \$10 for Juniors 21 and under per match- Make checks payable to NF&G Assn.

RULES: Current NRA High-power Rifle Rules Apply. **CLASSIFICATION:** NRA MRP classification will be used.

EQUIPMENT: Rifles are defined in current NRA rules

3.1 Service, 3.3 Match, 3.3.1 Palma, 3.3.3 AR Tactical and 3.4 for F-Open and F-TR Rifles

AMMUNITION: Any that is safe. Furnished by competitor.

NO 223 projectiles lighter than 68 grains or 16" barreled AR15 rifles allowed at 500 or 600 yds

TARGETS: MR-63 at 300yds, MR-65 at 500yds, MR-1 at 600yds. Electronic Shot Marker System

RANGE OPERATION: Electronic Targets will be used but if they fail be ready Competitors will be required to score and pull targets. Competitors failing to report promptly for scoring and pit duty will be disqualified.

Competitors must bring their own Wifi Phone or Tablets for shooting and scoring duties.

Shooters are expected to come with known Zero's and Properly Functioning rifles and ammo.

Anyone not on paper after 5 shots or can't consistently hold paper will not be allowed to continue. No Refunds

You shoot an E target sensor you pay the \$50 replacement cost for each sensor shot. Sensor Wires \$20 each.

All Leveridge events Enforce a Strict Muzzle down policy - to ensure no rounds leave NFGA property.

When closing your bolt your rifle will be pointed down range at your target or below it! You will get 1 warning.

Course of Fire:

STAGE#1, 300yds, prone, unlimited sighting shots and 15 record shots in 23-minute block time.

STAGE#2, 500yds, prone, unlimited sighting shots and 15 record shots in 23-minute block time.

STAGE#3, 600yds, prone, unlimited sighting shots and 15 record shots in 23-minute block time.

Block time = 3-minute prep + 5 Minutes for unlimited sighters + 15 Minutes for 15 record shots

For a total of 23 minutes to use at the shooter's discretion.

DIRECTIONS: From the F.E. Everett Turnpike:

From north, take exit 10, turn left on Industrial Way to Route 3A, Turn right onto Rte 3A, go about 1 mile, turn right onto Manchester St., take next right, Al Paul Lane ends at the club.

From South, take exit 10, turn right onto industrial Way and follow directions above.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Bring your own food / water. Not available at range.
