**MATCH DATES:** (5 Matches)

Sunday 5/4, Sunday 9/21, Sunday 9/28. Saturday 10/4 & Saturday 10/11

**FIRING BEGINS:** 9AM – Squadding 8 – 8:45am

**ENTRIES:** Limited to 28 individual competitors. Pre-Registration is NOT required.

**FEES:** Match fee \$10 (Please bring Exact change) Make Checks payable to NFGA.

**CLASSIFICATION:** This is *NOT* a CMP Sanctioned event. No classifications will be used.

**OPEN TO:** Any / All shooters with proper safe equipment.

Juniors / New Shooters are welcome but please contact the match director prior to match. (We will help)

**RANGE OPERATION:** NFGA Provided Electronic Targets will be used. Competitors are to bring their own Wi-Fi Phone or Tablet for shooting and scoring. Some / limited loaner tablets available if needed.

**Anyone not on paper after 5 shots will not be allowed to continue firing. All are expected to show up for the match with known zeros and a properly functioning rifle. No Refunds Once Firing Begins.**

**\*>If you shoot an ET sensor you pay \$50 for each sensor. If you shoot a wire, you pay \$20 per wire.**

**TARGETS:** 200 Yard SR Target for all stages of fire. Targets will be electronically scored.

Competitors will score another relay. Shooters will self-score if we end up with only one relay.

**RULES:** CMP rules will apply. Alibi will be allowed for Stage 2

Competitors are expected to ensure their equipment is in good working condition and they have zero's

**AMMUNITION:** Not provided. No Tracer or Armor Piercing ammo allowed.

**COURSE OF FIRE:** This will follow the GSMM "A" Course of fire.

STAGE 1: Up to five (5) sighting shots and ten (10) shots for record slow fire, prone position.  
Fifteen (15) minute time limit.

STAGE 2: Ten (10) shots rapid prone (from standing) in a time limit of eighty-three (83) seconds.

STAGE 3: Ten (10) shots slow fire standing, ten (10) minute time limit.

**RIFLES ALLOWED / GENERAL INFORMATION:** The Garand, Springfield, Vintage Rifle, & Modern Military matches were developed by the Civilian Marksmanship Program for competitors to compete with "as-issued" U.S. M1 Garand, M1903, M1917, M1A, & AR-15 rifles. However, any safe Rifle can be used. (\*Shooters may stay in the prone position for safety if needed in the rapid stage)

**FTR / AR Tactical Shooters are welcome to shoot the whole match from a bipod if desired**

**AWARDS:** There will be no awards for these events
