EQUIPMENT: AR-15A2 Service Rifle. Rifles are provided for Clinic use by NFGA.

Students may use their own rifle if proper and approved but the clinic fee will still be \$75.

COURSE OF FIRE: All fired from 200 yards

Two 3 shot sighting groups Prone position, the four single fire sighters. 40 Shots for record

10 record Shots Prone single load

10 record shots Prone Rapid. Load and 2 Rd Mag then 8 Rd Mag in 70 seconds

10 record shots Sitting Rapid. Load and 2 Rd Mag then 8 Rd Mag in 60 seconds

10 record shots Standing / Offhand. Single load

TARGETS: All at 200 yards SR Target

GENERAL INFORMATION: Dress for the weather. No Lunch break, we eat on the go.

Bring your own food and water as none is provided or available at the range.

RANGE OPERATION: Competitors will be required to score and pull targets.

DIRECTIONS: from Rte 3 FE Everett Turnpike:
