



## 2024 MILITARY RIFLE / GSMM MATCHES

### **MATCH DATES:**

Sunday 4/28, Saturday 9/14 & Sunday October 20th following the NHPRL league match.

**FIRING BEGINS:** Approximately 11:30 AM – Noon once NHPRL matches are complete

**HOSTED BY:** Nashua Fish and Game Association 21 Al Paul Lane Merrimack, NH 03054

**ENTRIES:** Limited to 30 individual competitors. Pre-Registration is NOT required.

**FEES:** Match fee \$10 payable at range on match date. Make Checks payable to NFGA.

**CLASSIFICATION:** This is *NOT* a CMP Sanctioned event. No classifications will be used.

**OPEN TO:** Any / All shooters with proper safe equipment.

Juniors and new shooters are welcome but please contact the match director prior to the match.

**RANGE OPERATION:** NFGA Provided Electronic Targets will be used. Competitors are to bring their own Wi-Fi Phone or Tablet for shooting and scoring. Some loaner tablets available if needed.

**Anyone not on paper after 5 shots will not be allowed to continue firing. All are expected to show up for the match with known zeros and a properly functioning rifle. No Match Fee Refunds.**

**(If you shoot an ET sensor you pay \$50 each sensor. If you shoot a wire you pay \$20 per wire.)**

**TARGETS:** 200 Yard SR Target for all stages of fire. Targets will be electronically scored. Competitors will be required to complete their own scorecards if we end up only 1 relay

**RULES:** CMP rules will apply. Alibi will be allowed for Stage 2

Competitors are expected to ensure their equipment is in good working condition and they have zero's

**AMMUNITION:** Not provided. No Tracer or Armor Piercing ammo allowed.

**COURSE OF FIRE:** This will follow the GSMM "A" Course of fire.

STAGE 1: Up to five (5) sighting shots and ten (10) shots for record slow fire, prone position.

Fifteen (15) minute time limit.

STAGE 2: Ten (10) shots rapid prone (from standing) in a time limit of eighty-three (83) seconds.

STAGE 3: Ten (10) shots slow fire standing, ten (10) minute time limit.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** The Garand, Springfield, Vintage Rifle, & Modern Military matches were developed by the Civilian Marksmanship Program for competitors to compete with "as-issued" U.S. M1 Garand, M1903, M1917, M1A, & AR-15 rifles. However, any safe functional rifle can be used.

**AWARDS:** There will be no awards given for this match.
