NEW HAMPSHIRE STATE HIGH POWER RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP

(*Match May be Reduced to 80 rounds at Match Director Discretion)

MATCH DATE: Sunday October 6th, 2024 Firing Starts at: 9:00 am.

SQUADDING: Squadding Starts at 200-yard line 1 Hour before firing and closes 15 minutes before firing.

OPEN TO: ALL NRA Members Preferred but Not Required

FEES: \$40.00 Adults / \$20 Juniors

Correct Change Cash Preferred. Make any checks payable to Nashua Fish and Game Assoc.

ENTRIES: Limited to 36 competitors. (Max 3 relays of 12 – 1st Come 1st squad. No Advance Entries)

CLASSIFICATION: NRA classification system will be used.

RULES: Alibi's will be allowed.

*CMP Rules will be used for any E Target Missing shots in Rapids.

RANGE OPERATION: (* All are expected to come with known zeros and properly functioning rifles)

Shotmarker Electronic Targets will be used. No ammo lighter than 68 grains may be fired at 600 yards.

YOU SHOOT IT & U OWN IT: \$50 per Sensor & \$20 per Wire shot paid by the person that shoots it.

Muzzle Down Rule: Strictly Enforced **OPEN BOLTINDICATOR:** Will be required to be used.

RIFLE: NRA Match Rifle, Service Rifle M1, M14 or M16 or civilian equivalent may be used.

COURSE OF FIRE: 100 rounds 3-minute prep period before each stage.

Stage 1: Offhand, 2 sighters then 20 record, 200 yards, 22 minutes Target SR @ 200 yards

Stage 2: Sitting Rapid 2 ss then two 63 second 10 shot strings, 200 yards Target SR @ 200yards

Stage 3: Prone Rapid 2 ss then two 73 second 10 shot strings, 300 yards Target SR-3 @ 300 yards

Stage 4: Prone, 2 sighters then 20 record, 600 yards, 22 minutes Target MR-1 @ 600 yards

Stage 5: Prone, 2 sighters then 20 record, 600 yards, 22 minutes Target MR-1 @ 600 yards

NOTE: Match Director has the discretion to omit stage 5 on Match Day

AWARDS: (*If more than 15 Total Competitors)

The Highest Scoring New Hampshire Resident Shooter (regardless of rifle type) is the State Champion.

*Must be more than 2 NH Resident Shooters for this award.

*Gets the option of \$100 cash or a Custom-Made Plaque.

The Match Winner – If not a New Hampshire Resident - \$80 cash or a Custom-Made Plaque.

NRA Class Awards: (*If more than 25 Total Competitors)

\$20 Cash awarded to each of the highest scoring shooters in each NRA Class.

Rifle Types will be combined and there must be a minimum of 5 shooters in each class for an award.

If there are not enough shooters in the lower classes, they will be moved up in classification for awards to get to 5 minimum for a class award.

No person is eligible for more than one open or class award.

Potluck Prize: (*All Competitors are eligible. Must be Present to Win)

At the end of the match all scorecards will be shuffled and one random scorecard drawn.

That person will win a box of 1000 Wolf Small Rifle Primers or the option of \$60 cash.

Must be present to win the Potluck prize. Cards will be randomly drawn until someone present wins.
