DIRECTIONS: from (rte 3) F. E. Everett Turnpike:

From North, take exit 10, turn left on "Industrial Way to Route 3A". Turn right onto Route 3A, go about 1 mile, turn right onto Manchester St. Take next right which is Al Paul Lane. Al Paul Lane ends at club entrance.

From South, take exit 10 off Rt3, turn right onto Industrial Way and follow directions above.

ENTRIES: Limited to 32 individual competitors. Entries accepted at range on match dates.

FEES: Match fee Adults \$30 Juniors \$10 (21 and under) Payable at range on match date.

Make Checks payable to NFGA.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rules. No Muzzle Brakes Allowed

OPEN BOLT INDICATOR: will be required to be used. All NFGA Range Safety Rules Apply.

No projectiles lighter than 68 grains may be fired at 600 yards.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA Classification System will be used. Scores go to the NRA after last match.

(* Any shooter attending all 8 matches will have their lowest score removed from aggregate / average)

OPEN TO: Any / All shooters with match experience and the proper safe equipment.

RANGE OPERATION: NFGA Provided Electronic Targets will be used by all in these matches.

Competitors need to bring a wifi Personal Tablet or Smartphone to connect to Shotmarker Targets

Anyone not on paper after 5 shots will not be allowed to continue firing.

All are expected to show up for match with known zero's and properly functioning rifle.

No Match Fee Refunds

(NOTE: You shoot an ET Sensor you pay \$50 each, Shot Sensor Wires pay \$20 each)

COURSE OF FIRE: Four 20 Shot Strings per Match

Match 1: Unlimited Sighters and 20 shots for record in a Block Time of 25 Minutes

Shooter must declare to scorer when record shots will start by stating clearly "going for record".

Matches 2,3 & 4: Two Sighters and 20 shots for record in a block time of 22 Minutes.

A total of 80 rounds maximum for record each match day.

If anyone wants to shoot less than 4 strings of 20 they may do so but match fee is the same.

Scores Average for NRA Report at the end of the league will be calculated only from record shots fired.

RIFLE: NRA

Any Rifle (Any Sight), Palma Rifle, Service Rifle, F Class Open Rifle, FTR or AR Tactical may be used.

AWARDS: There will be no awards.
