ENTRIES: 32 MAX - No Pre-Register Allowed (8 E Targets 4 relays. 1st in squad line 1st serve)

SQUADDING: Squadding Starts 1 Hour before firing and closes 15 minutes before firing.

RULES: All Current NRA Rules will apply.

RANGE OPERATION:

Match will be fired on Electronic Targets. Competitors are to bring own tablets or smart phones.
All Competitors will be required to provide scoring duties for other shooters on their firing point
No MUZZLE BRAKES Allowed. No Projectile lighter than 68gr. may be fired beyond 300 yards.
MUZZLES DOWN: Mandatory Muzzles Horizontal or Lower when closing bolts on a live round.
EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR: Will be required to be used at all times except during live fire.

~ COMPETITOR EXPECTATIONS ~

All are expected to have known zeros and properly operating equipment to include ammo
Anyone with ammo not registering or able to hold paper will cease firing and forfeit match fee

RIFLES NRA: Any NRA Approved Prone Class of Rifle may be used
Competitor must shoot the same rifle through all stages of fire.

COURSE OF FIRE: 80 rounds

Block time and / or Infiltration may be used

Stage 1: 600 Yards Unlimited Sighters and 20 shots for record (NRA 600 Yard Targets)

Stage 2: 600 Yards 2 Sighters and 20 shots for record (NRA 600 Yard Targets)

Stage 3: 600 Yards 2 Sighters and 20 shots for record (NRA 600 Yard Targets)

STOP for Target Face Changeout BEFORE starting Stage 4

Stage 4: 600 Yards 2 Sighters and 20 shots for record (**NRA 500 Yard Targets**)

Aggregate of Matches 1 – 3 will be submitted for any NRA National Records fired
State Champions in each Class will be determined by the Aggregate of Stages 1–4

~AWARDS~

State Champion Plaque for the highest scoring NH Resident in each NRA Rifle Category
State Champions will have option of the Plaque or \$60 cash award.

Highest Scoring in each category of 5 or more if not a NH Resident Award will be \$40

** There must be a minimum of 5 NH Residents in each Category for State Champion Awards**
No Competitor will receive more than one award
