OPEN TO:

Any competitor 16 years of age or older and a US citizen may enter this match.

Service Rifle Shooters will get Squadding preference over any Match Rifle Shooters that want to shoot the match.

LOCATION:

Nashua Fish and Game 21 Al Paul Lane Merrimack, NH

FEES:

Total \$20.00. Exact Cash preferred - Make any checks to NFGA

TARGETS:

Shotmarker Electronic targets will be used. Competitors to bring personal wifi device to access targets interface

Missing Shots in Rapids:

If scorer verifies the shooter fired 10 shots AND no excessive shots 2 targets on either side of target.

If only nine shots recorded Shooter gets the value of the lowest recorded shot value for the missed shot.

If 2 or more shots did not record: Shooter gets the option to-

Accept the values of the lowest recorded shot for the missing shots

OR shoot another 10 shots and take the lowest values of that string for the missing shots.

RULES:

Open bolt indicators must be used. ALL current CMP Competition Rules and Regulations will be used.

COURSE OF FIRE:

National Match Course (no sighting shots)

All Competitors to comply with current CMP rules to include standing before the rapid-fire stages.

Stage One:

Slow fire, 200 yards, SR target, 10 shots standing; in 10 minutes.

Stage Two:

Rapid fire, 200 yards, SR target, 10 shots, standing to sitting or kneeling, 60 seconds.

Stage Three:

Rapid fire, 300 yards, SR-3 target, 10 shots, standing to prone, 70 seconds.

Stage Four:

Slow fire, 600 yards, MR-1 target, 20 shots prone in 20 minutes.

RIFLE and AMMO:

Rifles covered by NRA High Power Rifle Rules 3.1, 3.1.1 or 3.1.2 may be used.

COMPETITORS MUST SUPPLY THEIR OWN SAFE AMMUNITION

No ammo lighter than 68 grains allowed to be fired from 600 yards

AWARDS:

CMP Provided Place Pins will be awarded according to CMP Scores table

EIC Points earned determined by CMP EIC Points schedule per number of "eligible" Non Distinguished Shooters
