

How To Get Qualified to shoot on Leveridge Unsupervised

Leveridge Range Certifications are held Monthly during the months of May thru October. Certifications are typically held at 5pm one Friday evening each month.

Once the dates for the season have been determined they will be listed on the NFGA Only Leveridge Schedule that gets posted at <https://nfga.org/high-power-rifle/> when it is complete.

*Each years Leveridge Events Schedule is typically finalized and posted by mid to late April

10-day Minimum Prior Pre-Registration is Mandatory for Leveridge Range Certifications

Previous Fowler Range Certification is required, then>

Step 1: > Fully Read the Leveridge Qualification Procedure document at [https://nfga.org/wp-content/uploads/rules/NFGA Rule Book Appendix A 2025.pdf#nameddest=Leveridge](https://nfga.org/wp-content/uploads/rules/NFGA_Rule_Book_Appendix_A_2025.pdf#nameddest=Leveridge) to decide if you want to qualify for 200 Standing Only, 600 Prone (which covers prone at all yard lines) or both.

Step 2: > Look up the dates of the monthly qualifications on the Leveridge Schedule and / or online calendar to determine which month's qualification you would like to Pre-register to attend.

Step 3: > Fill out the Pre-Registration form and email it to the Leveridge Governor

>No Later Than 10 days prior to the monthly qualification you would like to attend. <

This form lets the governor know if you have adequate rifle(s) and ammo for the yard lines you want to qualify for. Also that you have a known zero and know your sights / scope come-ups for distances.

Step 4: > Once the Governor receives your pre-registration form, if all looks good for rifle, ammo, zeros and yard lines come-ups you will be sent the link and passcode to take the online / open book rules exam.

Step 5: > After you pass the rules exam you will be invited to the Range Orientation and live fire part of the qualification. To Pass – You must be able to hold paper at yard lines but the test is more about safe gun handling from the time you rifle leaves your vehicle until it is back in your vehicle after the qualification.
