MATCH DATE: Father's Day - June 19th 2022

FIRING STARTS AT: 9:00am Squadding opens at 8am and closes at 8:45 (Squad at 200 yard line)

ENTRIES: Limited to 48 individual competitors. No Pre-Registration:

FEES: Match fee \$10 payable at range on match date. Make Checks payable to NFGA.

CLASSIFICATION: This is not an NRA or CMP Sanctioned even so no classifications will be used

OPEN TO: Any / All shooters with match experience and the proper safe equipment.

RANGE OPERATION: Competitors will be required to score and pull targets.

This Match is typically fired by Experienced Rifle Shooters that want to have a fun day shooting Vintage Military yet quality and safe firearms like M1A, M1 Garand's, Springfield's, Mauser's, British Enfield's, SKS etc. Some shoot AR15 variants. This is all fired at 200 yards so even a 16" barreled AR15 with a red dot sight could safely be used. There is no sling allowed to be used for support for standing (like in the CMP Vintage Rifle Matches) but sling use is recommended for sitting and Prone stages.

Experienced shooters may bring a family member or friend to shoot in this match, but they will be required to coach them 100% while shooting, scoring and pulling / marking targets in the pits.

No Muzzle Brakes Allowed.

Typical Strict Muzzle Down policy applies 100% of the time when closing bolts on live ammo.

Trigger Fingers stay OUTSIDE Trigger Guard until you are aiming at your target.

Anyone that can't stay on target or breaks safety rules will not be allowed to continue firing. No refunds.

TARGETS: 200 yards – SR Target for all stages of fire. Paper Targets with Pits

AMMO: Not provided – Competitors are to provide safe ammo for their rifle. NO Tracer Ammo Allowed. 223 / 5.56 55 grain ball ammo available for purchase on site for this event ONLY. (\$40 for 60 Rounds)

COURSE OF FIRE:

Prone Slow Fire:

3 Minutes Preparation, 2 Sighters and 20 Shots for Record in a Block time limit of 25 Minutes.

Prone Rapid Fire:

3 Minutes Prep, 2 minutes for 2 sighters then 10 shots Prone in 70 seconds with a magazine change.

Sitting Rapid Fire:

3 Minutes Prep, 2 minutes for 2 sighters then 10 shots Sitting in 60 seconds with a magazine change.

Standing / Offhand:

3 Minutes Preparation, 2 Sighters and 10 Shots for Record in a Block time limit of 13 Minutes.

Coaching is allowed by experienced shooters to keep newer shooters safe.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Bring your own food and water. Be prepared to eat on the go.

AWARDS: There will be no awards.
