Load and 2 Rd Mag then 8 Rd Mag in 70 seconds 10 record shots Sitting Rapid. Load and 2 Rd Mag then 8 Rd Mag in 60 seconds 10 record shots Standing / Offhand. Single load **TARGETS:** All at 200 yards SR Target

GENERAL INFORMATION: Dress for the weather. No Lunch break, we eat on the go. Estimate Complete by 2pm. Bring your own Eye and Ear protection. Also bring food and water as none is provided or available at the range. **RANGE OPERATION:** Competitors will be required to score and pull targets. Bring writing utensils for scoring.
